Coir Logs

Coir logs are made from densely packed coconut fibre which is wrapped with coir netting. These logs allow water to pass through while sediment and silt are retained. The substantial size, weight and rigidity of coir logs makes them suitable for controlling waterway erosion on steep embankments and in high rain events.

Being completely constructed from natural materials has the added benefit of making coir logs 100% biodegradable. Coir logs decompose slowly, enriching the soil with useful nutrients that provide a habitat for plants and animals. Timber stakes are recommended for installation.

- Made from natural and renewable coir fibres
- Pre-drilled holes for quick and easy stake installation
- High density fibres for increased performance and lifespan
